# Community Governance Review 2015/16 Issue 7

### **Moreton Hall Area**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that St Edmundsbury Borough Council ("the Council"), in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the Act"), has undertaken a Community Governance Review of certain parishes in its area.

The Council has now decided to what extent it will give effect to the recommendations made in respect of issue 7 in the Community Governance Review 2015/16, which affected the parishes of:

- Bury St Edmunds
- Great Barton

· Rushbrooke with Rougham.

## The decision is that:

- 1. The parishes listed above should not be abolished;
- 2. The Moreton Hall area of Bury St Edmunds should remain in Bury St Edmunds Parish, and no new parish should be created for this area.
  - N.B. Please see the separate decision for issues 4, 6 and 8 in relation to the boundary of Bury St Edmunds Parish;
- 3. The names of the parishes listed above should not be altered;
- 4. The parishes should continue to have town/parish councils as currently applicable; and
- 5. No changes be made to the electoral arrangements that apply to the parish/town councils listed above in respect of this particular issue (but see the decisions for issues 3 and 4 in relation to Great Barton and Rushbrooke with Rougham Parish Councils respectively).

# Reasons for the decision

The Council considered that, having tested the matter through consultation, there was insufficient evidence of support to justify such a significant change to the current arrangements.
