There is really no need for these overly restrictive measures. The PCs are in tune with their residents and those who physically cannot make it to a polling station have several alternative measures they may take.

It appears there are bureaucrats creating problems where none exist in reality, disenfranchising the majority of residents as a result.

You only have to visit the figures of those voting in person from Westley village in the last WSDC elections, compared with all elections in the past, at the wholly inappropriate location designated on the Westley Estate in Bury St Edmunds where no public transport was available to and from the village and no pavements either. The turnout here was dire and could have seriously affected the actual Ward result of the vote in a close run contest.

It is now proposed to ask the residents of Denham to jump into their cars, get on their bikes or walk quite a distance to the next village to cast their votes.
