

Statutory review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN that West Suffolk Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections 18A to 18E of the Representation of the People Act 1983 shall undertake a review of the parliamentary polling districts and parliamentary polling places within its area.

This review follows the publication of the Local Government Boundary Commission for England's final recommendations regarding electoral arrangements for West Suffolk Council.

The consultation period for this review will commence on **Tuesday 6 November 2018** and end on **Tuesday 11 December 2018**.

We are looking for feedback on any aspect of the proposed polling districts and/or polling places and invite representation and comments from interested parties. Although the review is of polling districts and polling places it is accepted that polling stations are linked to the review and comments are invited regarding polling stations currently used and/or any suggested alternatives. Please note the review does not cover Ward and Parish boundaries.

The council would welcome any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability to comment on the Acting Returning Officer's representations or on any other matter. Any comments should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling stations.

This review will require submissions to be made by the Acting Returning Officer for the Bury St Edmunds and West Suffolk Constituencies and the part of the South Suffolk Constituency within the West Suffolk Council authority area. These submissions will be published and available for inspection at West Suffolk House, Western Way, Bury St Edmunds, IP33 3YU and at www.westsuffolk.gov.uk/pdreview by Thursday 13 December 2018.

All submissions, correspondence, minutes and decisions relating to the review will be made public on the Council's website as the review progresses. It is intended that the Council will publish its final proposals during January 2019.
