Dear Cllr Brown,

I hope this email finds you well. As you know, we have recently undertaken an audit of all polling stations and at the Council meeting last Tuesday it was agreed that an interim review of polling places would be carried out for polling stations that do not provide electors with reasonable facilities for voting or are not accessible to electors who are disabled. Polling stations that are not available for the elections on 4 May

2023 are also included as part of this review. See item 10 of the agenda: Agenda for Council on Tuesday 13 December 2022, 7.00 pm (westsuffolk.gov.uk)

With regard to the Ampton polling place, in Ampton, Little Livemere and Timworth parish, the feedback from the audit and site visit was that the Ampton Social Village social club is not used regularly and therefore neglected. It is not accessible due to the condition of the pathway to the building and external and internal steps. The building clerk advised that there are no plans to make the building accessible. We do not believe that an alternative facility is available in the village. It is therefore recommended that we combine with a polling station in a neighbouring polling district (Ingham). This will future-proof our polling arrangements and provide better accessibility for all electors.

We would welcome your feedback regarding this proposal and if there are any suggestions as to alternative locations where a polling station could be held in Ampton, then we would be pleased to receive details so that we could investigate this further.

When making comments or suggesting alternative venues, please consider that whatever arrangements we make, they should be accessible to disabled electors and provide reasonable facilities both for electors and polling staff.

The deadline for responses to the consultation is Friday 27 January 2023 and the revised polling arrangements will be published on 10 February 2023. We will notify you of the outcome.
