Whereas Her Majesty The Queen by Warrant under Her Royal Signet and Sign Manual bearing date the Twenty-third day of October 2019 hath signified unto The Most Noble Edward William Duke of Norfolk Earl Marshal and Hereditary Marshal of England that She hath been graciously pleased to give and grant unto **West Suffolk Council** Her Royal Licence and Authority that it may bear and use the Arms and Crest granted and assigned unto West Suffolk County Council on the Ninth day of June 1959 the said Armorial Bearings being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms otherwise the said Licence and Permission to be void and of none effect And forasmuch as the Earl Marshal did by Warrant under his hand and Seal bearing date the Fifth day of November 2019 authorize and direct Us to exemplify the said Arms and Crest pursuant to the tenor of the said Royal Warrant and according to the Laws of Arms We do hereby exemplify unto the said **West Suffolk Council** the Arms following that is to say: - Azure a Cross flory between five Martlets Or on a Chief Sable between two Mitres Argent two Arrows in saltire points downwards also Argent enfiled an Ancient Crown Or And for the Crest On a Wreath Or and Azure In front of two Arrows in saltire points downwards proper a Castle with two domed Towers Flags flying thereon Or on a Grassy Mount proper which Armorial Bearings are duly recorded in the College of Arms In witness whereof We have hereunto subscribed Our names this Twenty-first day of February 2020.
