Welcome back to Dear Neighbour, our newsletter that keeps you updated on West Suffolk Operational Hub, Bury St Edmunds.

December has seen another month of heightened activity across the project!

Groundworks are still the main focus of the project currently with foul and surface water drainage across the site, foundation preparation for steelwork and commencement of the fleet car-park bay concrete works.



Steelwork to the waste transfer station & baling building is complete in readiness for the cladding works. The landscape store steelwork will be commenced in 2019.

The roof is now on the depot and workshop building which enables us to commence the external side walls

Once this is complete the building will be virtually watertight and we can then commence the internal works. These works will include internal wall construction & first fix mechanical and electrical works.

We are planning on holding our next coffee morning on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2018 @10.00am. It's another opportunity for you to receive an update on the project and take a peak from our new viewing platform.

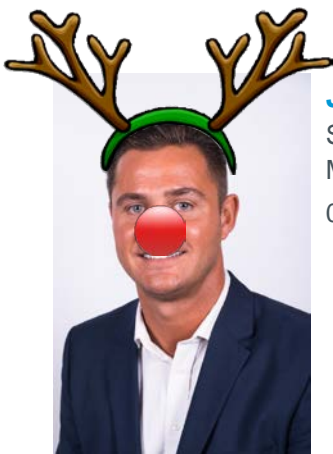
