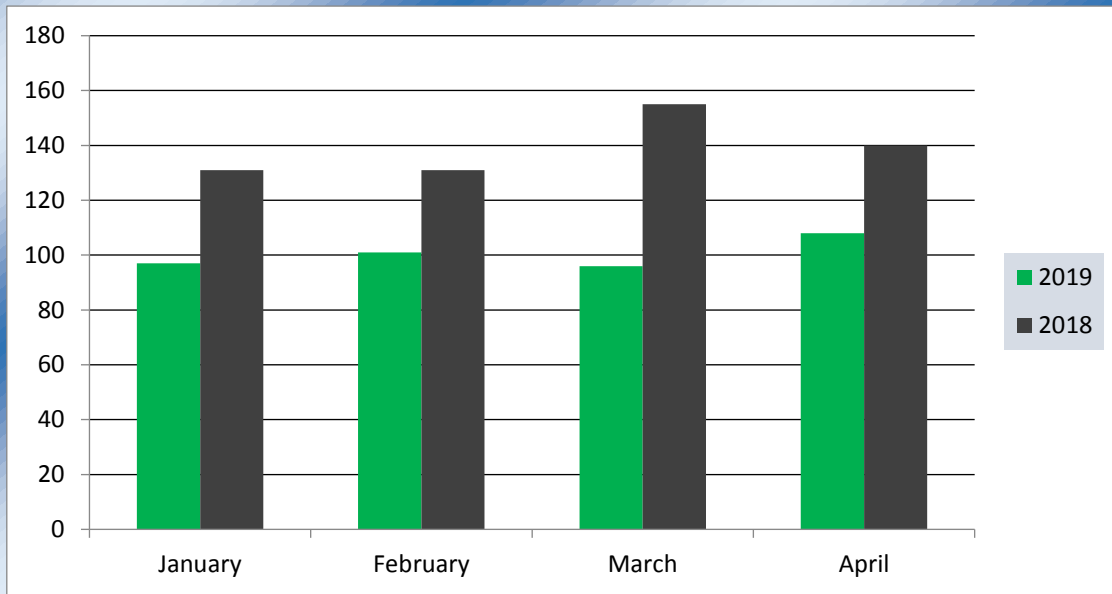

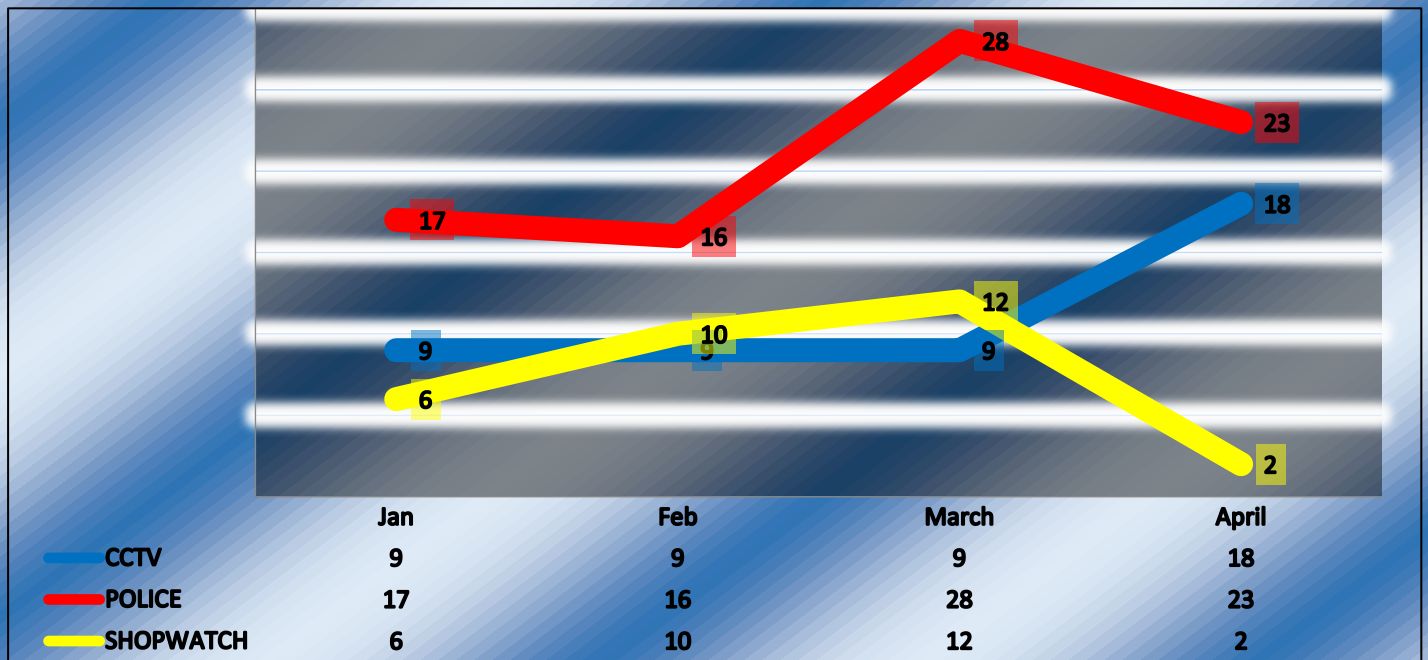

### Comparison between 2018 and 2019 Incidents



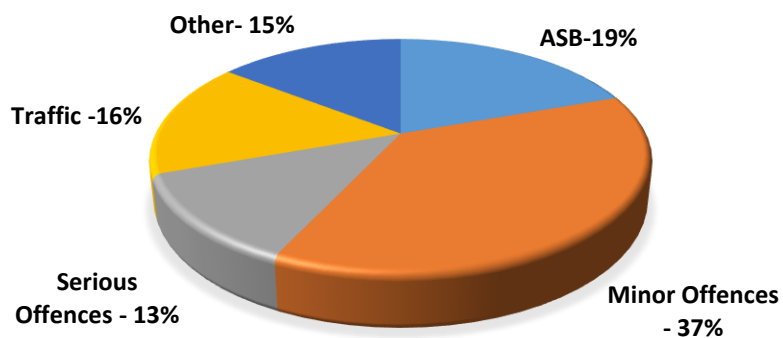
### ARRESTS BY CALL SOURCE Jan 19 to April 19



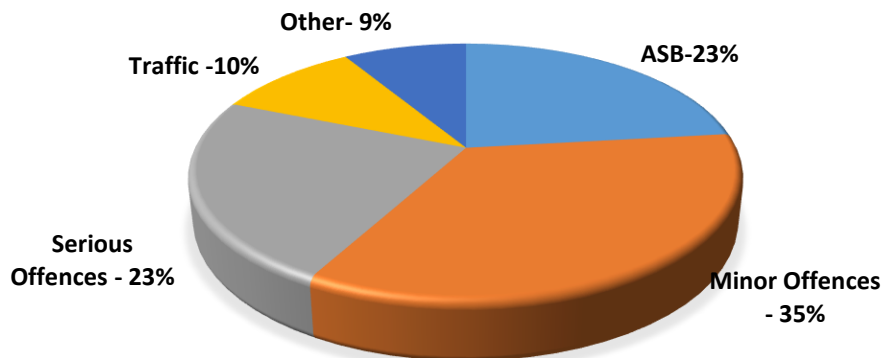

On the next 2 pages you will see each of the 6 town's incidents broken down into categories to better understand what crimes are happening in your area.

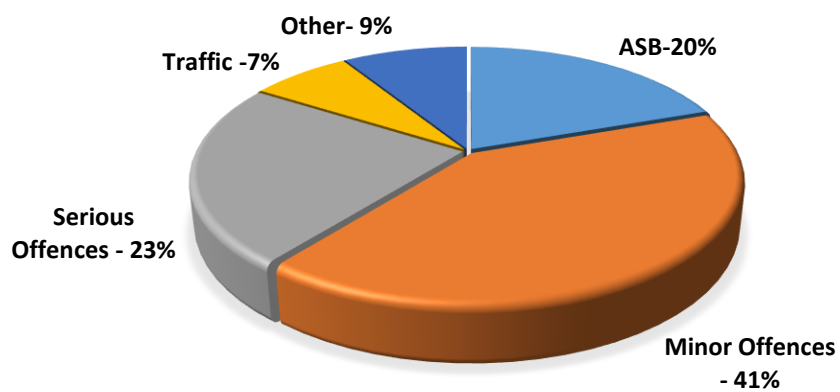

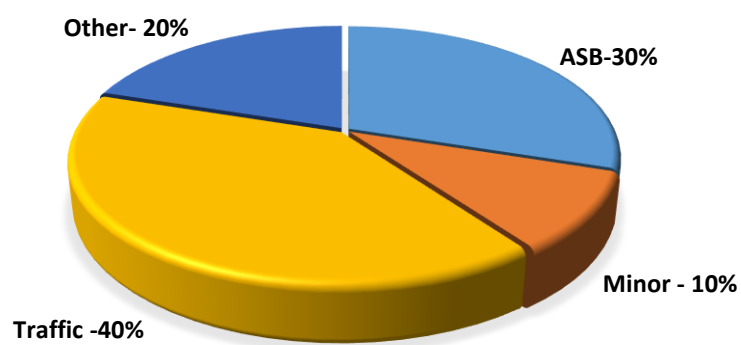

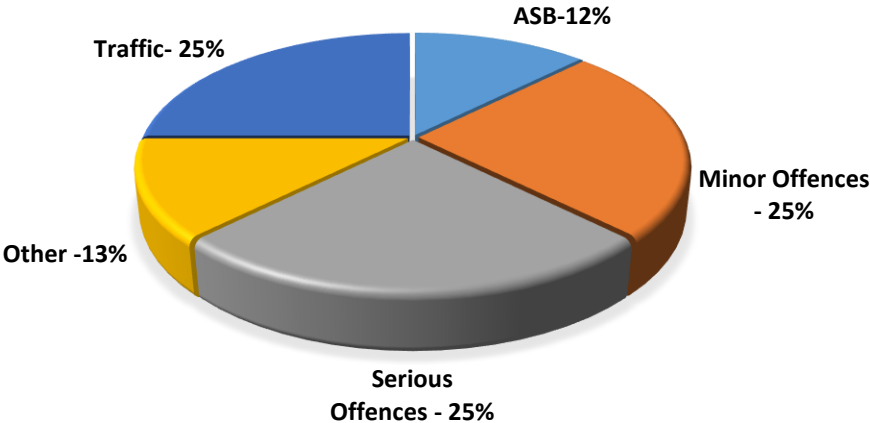
