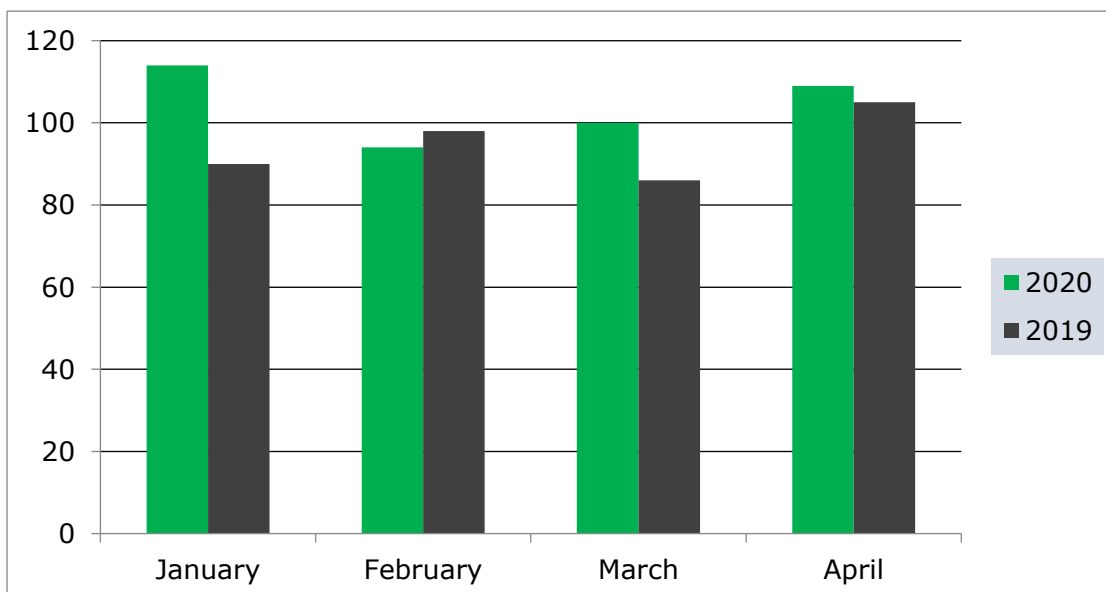

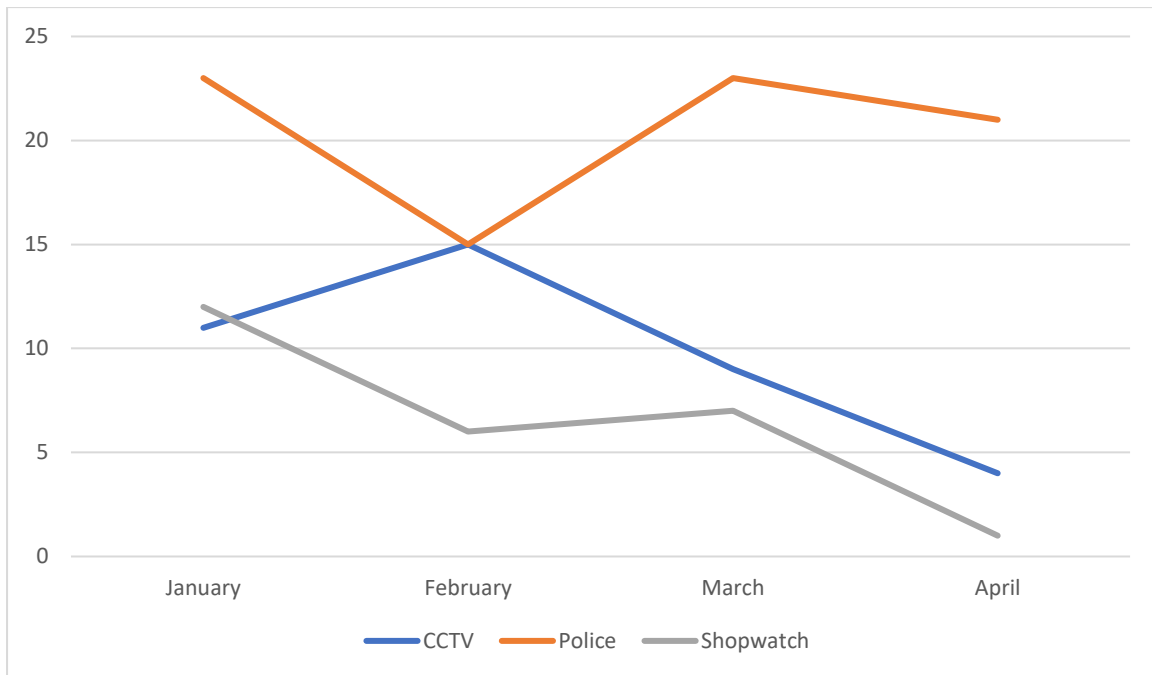

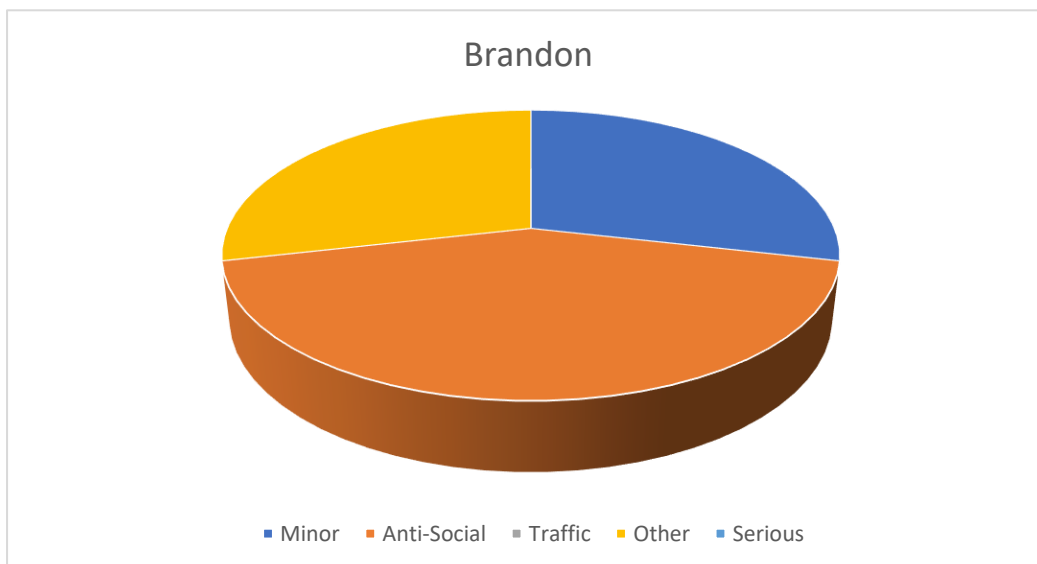


## Arrests by call source 1 January to 30 April

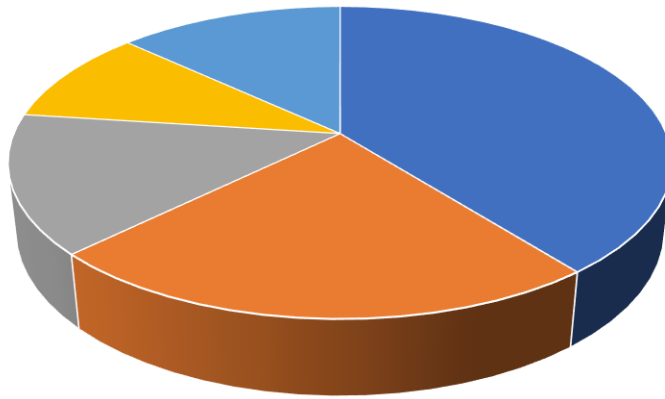

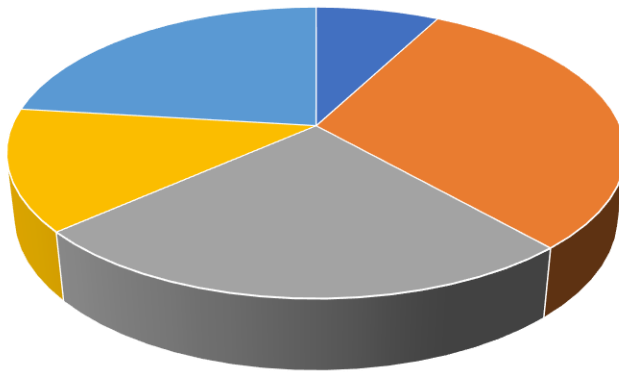

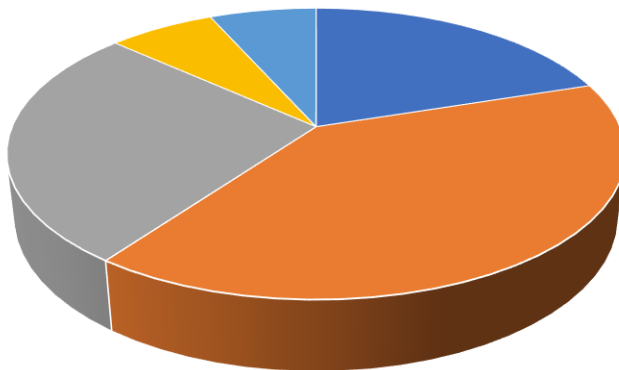

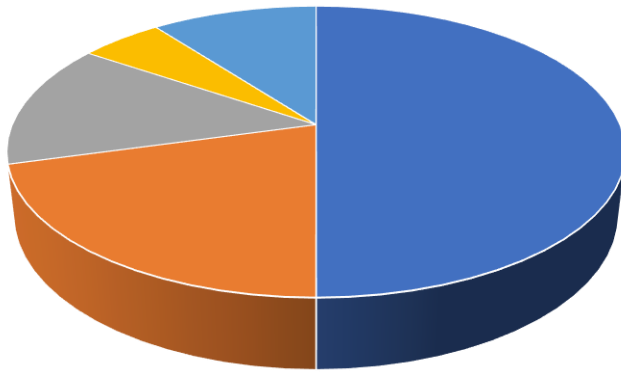

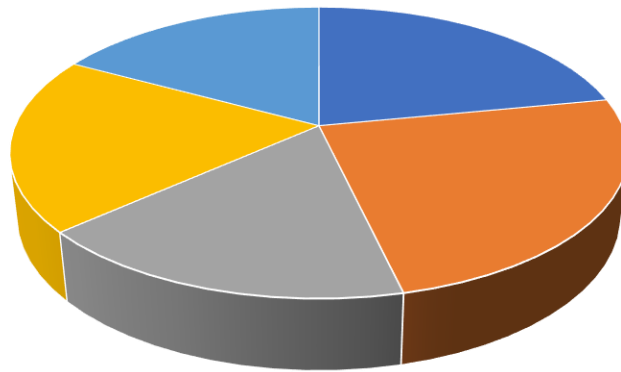
