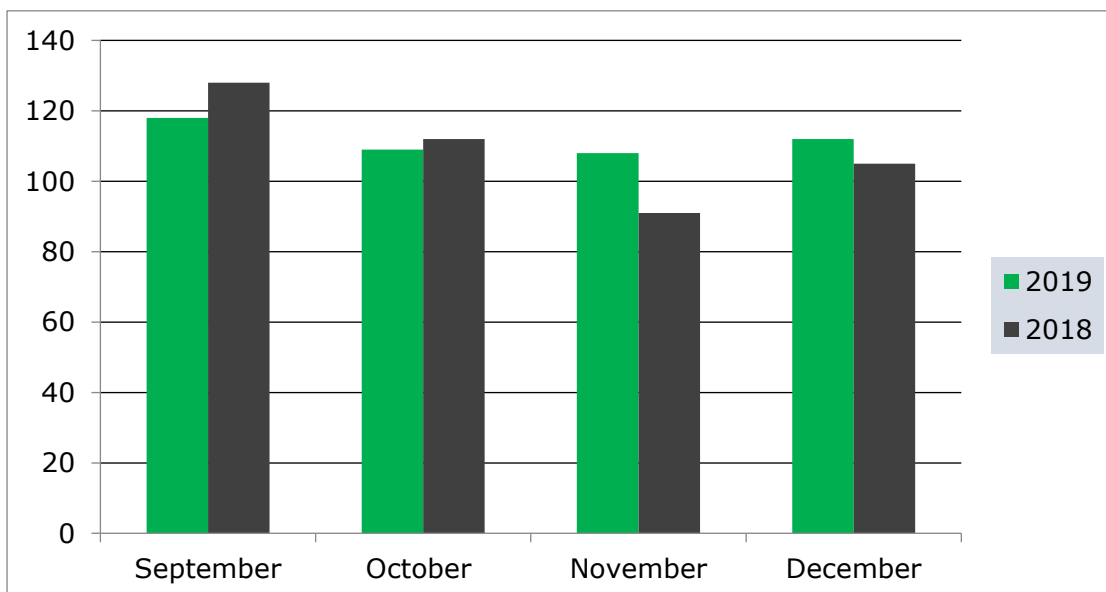

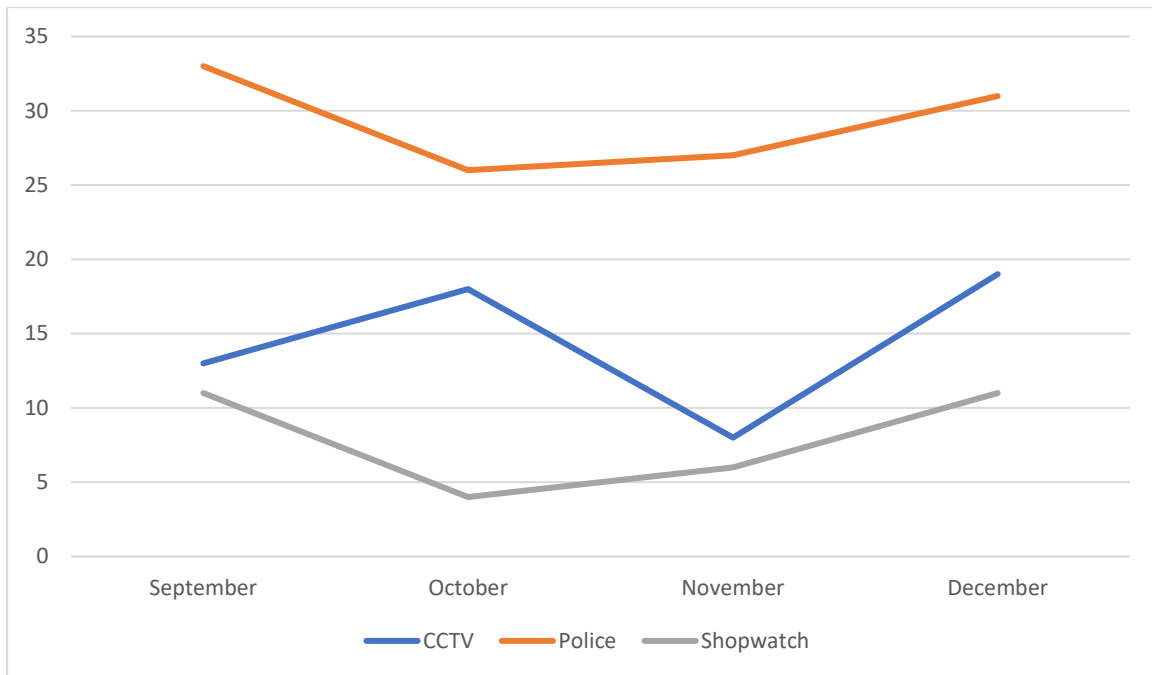

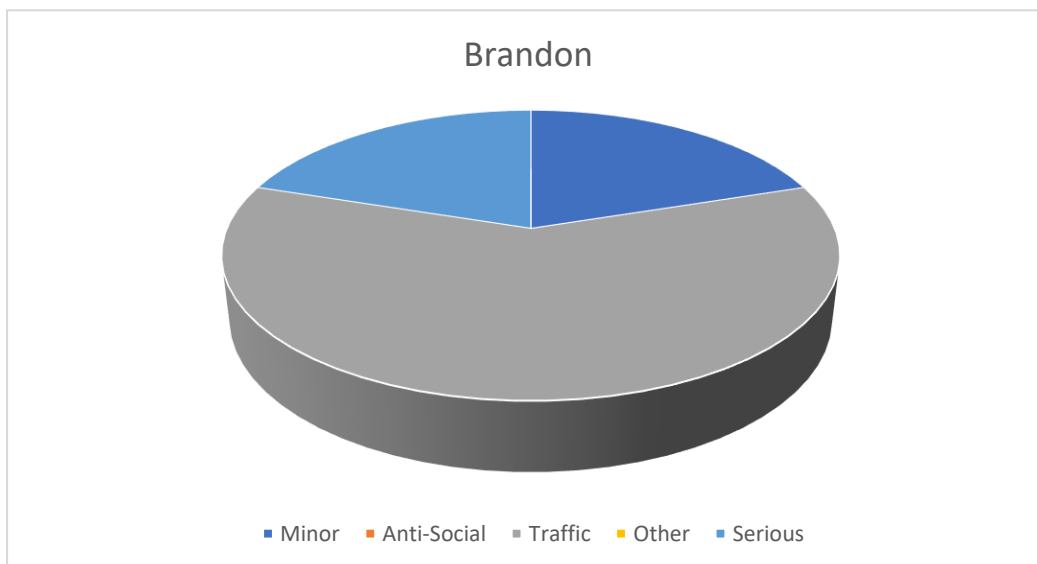


## Arrests by call source 1 September to 31 December

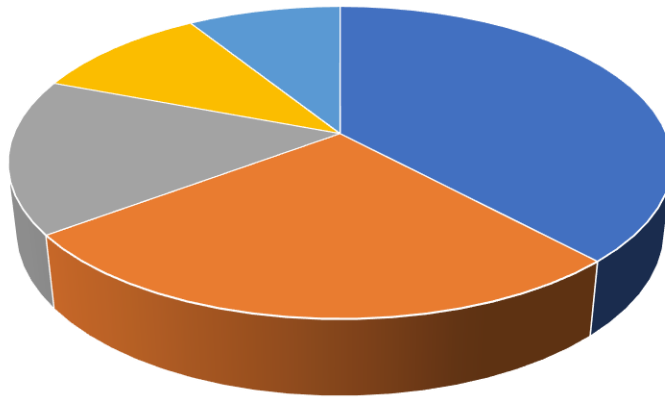

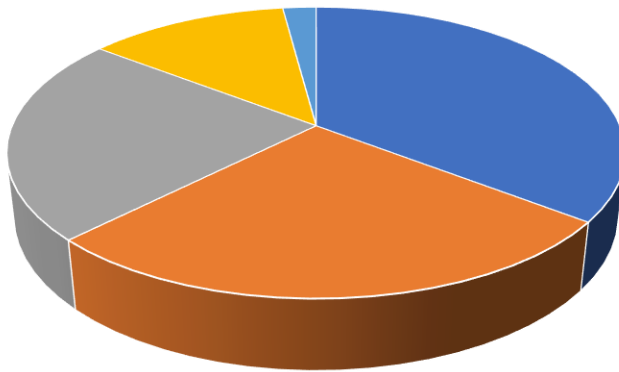

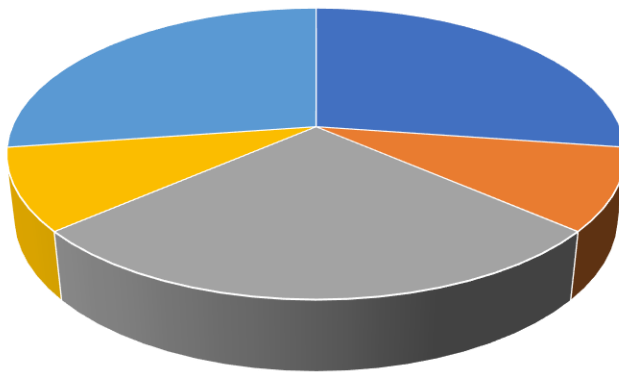

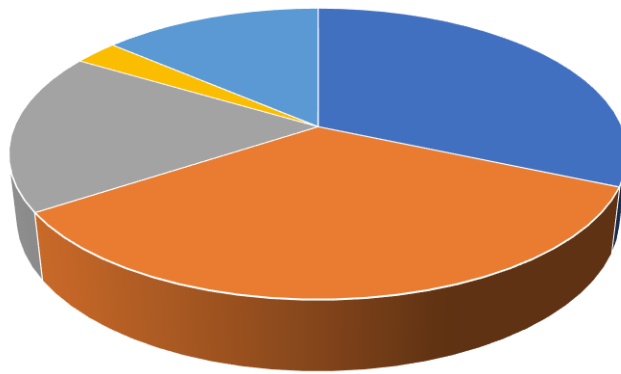

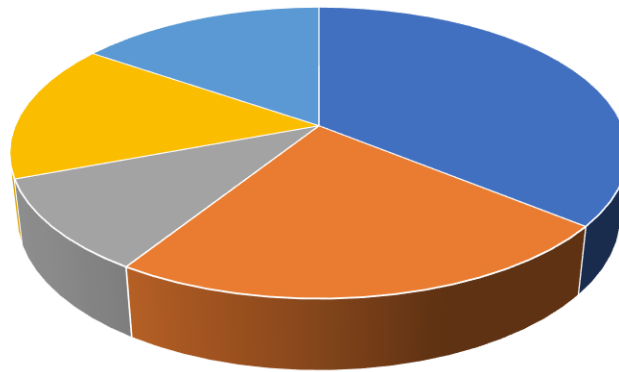
