3	Honington Sapiston	The parish warding arrangement for the Honington parish be removed.

Proposal of CGR Task and Finish Group

The parish warding arrangement for Honington parish (Station and Village wards) be removed. A map of the proposal is included on the next page.

The reasons for the recommendation include:

1. local preference (the change was requested by Honington cum Sapiston Parish Council); and
2. the new arrangements potentially provides a Parish Council which offers more effective and convenient local government.

Allocation of councillors

The minimum number of councillors for a Parish Council is five and there is no maximum number. The total electorate for the Honington cum Sapiston Parish Council is 689 electors (at February 2026) and guidance suggests a Parish Council size of 6 – 12 councillors. Each parish grouped under a common parish council must have at least one parish councillor.
