What is it?

A county-wide initiative designed to help Suffolk's clubs, groups, venues and organisations get back up and running safely and swiftly after lockdown. The Suffolk Community Restart programme is led by Community Action Suffolk, in partnership with Suffolk County Council and the county's borough and district councils.

Who's eligible?

Any voluntary sector organisation, meet-up, club, sports team, community venue or neighbourhood scheme.

What do you get?

- Online on-demand training to help with issues like health and safety
- Workshops and group communications with others like you
- Practical advice from the Community Action Suffolk team
- Access to apply for a Suffolk Community Restart Grant, giving you between £250 and £2,500 toward PPE, marketing, cleaning regimes
