# The St Edmundsbury (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018

Coming into force in accordance with Article 1(2)

St Edmundsbury Borough Council ("the Council"), in accordance with Section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 1 August 2016.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with Section 93 of the Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient.

The Council, in accordance with Section 100 of the Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that Section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 86 and 240(10) of the Act.

#### 1. Citation and Commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as the St Edmundsbury (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018.
- (2) It shall come into force on 1 April 2018.

#### 2. Interpretation

In this Order -

"Borough" means the Borough of St Edmundsbury;

"existing" means existing on the date this Order is made;

"map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the St Edmundsbury (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018" and deposited in accordance with Section 96(4) of the Act, and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number; "registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in

accordance with, Section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

#### 3. Effect of Order

This Order has effect subject to any agreement under Section 99 of the Act (agreements about incidental matters) relevant to any provision of this Order.

#### 4. Alteration of Parish Areas and the areas of Parish Wards

- (1) Each area shaded on sheets 1-2 of the map and specified in column (5) of the Schedule shall become a ward of the parish specified in column (4) of the Schedule.
- (2) The number of Parish Councillors for Great Barton parish (Severalls ward) will be two (2).
- (3) The number of Parish Councillors for Great Barton parish (North ward) will be nine (9).
- (4) The number of Parish Councillors for Rushbrooke with Rougham parish (North ward) will be two (2).
- (5) The number of Parish Councillors for Rushbrooke with Rougham parish (South ward) will be nine (9).

#### 5. Electoral Register

The registration officer for the Borough shall make such arrangements of, or adoption of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

#### 6. Order Date

1 April 2018 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
