Emissions

34 per cent reductions in total emissions compared to 2010 baseline.
Down 0.2 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

13 per cent reduction in total owned vehicle emissions compared to 2019 to 2020 baseline.
Down by 1 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

Consumption and energy

206 per cent increase in renewable energy compared to 2012 baseline.
Up 8 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

60 per cent less business travel compared to 2010 baseline.
Business travel up by 17 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

4 per cent reduction in total water consumption compared to 2010 to 2011 baseline.
Down 10 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

29 per cent increase in grid electricity consumption compared to 2019 to 2020 baseline.
Down 3 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

54 per cent increase in gas consumption compared to 2019 to 2020 baseline.
Down 8 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

35 per cent reduction in office printing compared to 2021 to 2022.
Down 21 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

Infrastructure and recycling

67 per cent reduction in total West Suffolk House waste compared to 2012 baseline.
Recycling rate 65 per cent, down 11 per cent compared to 2023 to 2024.

78 electric vehicles can be charged at the same time using public chargers installed by West Suffolk Council.
Energy delivered to drivers powered 546,241 miles.
