

**NOTICE FOR ALL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT HOLDERS
Bury St Edmunds**

5th November to 2nd December 2020

West Suffolk Council has agreed following the government announcement of the latest lockdown period to allow residential permit holders (all zones) free parking in all off-Street Car Parks.

Where can I park using my valid residential permit?

Any West Suffolk Council Off-Street Car Park, areas available to park are as follows - Ram Meadow, Parkway Multi Storey CP, Parkway Surface CP, Cattle Market CP, Lower Baxter St CP, School Yard East & West, St Andrews Flexi and long stay CP, Bury Leisure Centre CP, Robert Boby CP.

Where am I not allowed to park with my residential permit? Areas below are On-Street parking areas.

Residential permits are **NOT** valid for Angel Hill, Looms Lane, Hatter Street, Whiting Street, Lower Baxter St, Cotton Lane, Abbeygate, St, Churchgate St, Guildhall St, Chequers Sq, Lower Baxter Street, Town Centre, Buttermarket.

How long can I park for in an Off-Street Car Park with my residential permit?

24 hours a day until further notice. As long as your residential permit is valid and clearly on display.

Can I use a visitor permit in an Off-Street Car Park?

Yes, but it must be valid, filled out correctly and in date.

Can I use my disabled blue badge instead of my permit?

No, disabled blue badge charges still apply.
