

TYPES OF DEVELOPMENT REQUIRING PLANNING PERMISSION UNDER THE ARTICLE 4 DIRECTIONS: QUICK GUIDE TO SCHEDULE 2, TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995

The following apply to 'relevant locations' which, for the purposes of the Article 4 Direction, are a highway, waterway and open space. Other restrictions may also apply and are set out in the individual tables.

PART 1

Class A: The enlargement, improvement or other alteration of a dwellinghouse

Class B: The enlargement of a dwellinghouse consisting of an addition or alteration to its roof

Class C: Any other alteration to the roof of a dwellinghouse

Class D: The erection or construction of a porch outside any external door of a dwellinghouse

Class E: The provision within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse of any building or enclosure, swimming or other pool required for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwellinghouse as such, or the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of such a building or enclosure

Class F: The provision within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse of a hard surface for any purpose incidental enjoyment of the dwellinghouse as such

Class G: The provision within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse of a container for the storage of oil for domestic heating

Class H: The installation, alteration or replacement of a satellite antenna on a dwellinghouse or within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse

PART 2

Class A: The erection, construction, maintenance, improvement, or alteration of a gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure

Class B: The formation, laying out and construction of a means of access to a highway which is not a trunk road or a classified road, where that access is required in connection permitted by any Class in this schedule (other than by Class A of this part)

Class C: The painting of the exterior of any building or work

PART 31

Class A: Any building operation consisting of the demolition of a building

Class B: Any building operation consisting of the demolition of the whole or any part of any gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure
