**On the Claimant's application for directions for listing an oral renewal of an application for permission to proceed with an application for judicial review**

Following consideration of the documents lodged by the parties

Order by Neil Cameron QC sitting as a Deputy High Court Judge

1. The Claimant's renewed oral application for permission to proceed with an application for judicial review on grounds 1 and 2 shall be listed to be heard immediately before the substantive hearing.

**Observations**

1. The overriding objective of dealing with cases justly and at proportionate cost would best be achieved by listing the oral renewal hearing immediately before the substantive hearing as such an arrangement would
  - a. Ensure that as many aspects of the case as can be are dealt with on the same occasion (CPR 1.4(2)(i))
  - b. Save the parties the expense of having to attend on two separate occasions.
