ADOPTION STATEMENT

CORE STRATEGY

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 24 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development)(England)(Amendment) Regulations 2008 and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development)(England) Regulations 2004 that Forest Heath District Council adopted the Core Strategy Development Plan Document on 12 May 2010.

The Core Strategy sets out a vision, objectives, spatial strategy and overarching policies to guide development in the district up to 2026 (with housing projected to 2031). This document forms part of the Forest Heath Local Development Framework.

Paul Crysell, an Independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, considered the Core Strategy at an Examination in Public held between 15th December 2009 and 15th January 2010. The Inspector's Report, with its recommendations, was published on 13th April 2010. The adopted Core Strategy contains the Inspector's recommendations that are binding on the Council.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy Development Plan Document may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that (a) the document is not within the appropriate power, or (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with. An application under Section 113 must be made no later than the end of the six week period starting from 12 May 2010.
