

Wickhambrook Neighbourhood Plan information statement

Town & Country Planning Act 1990 Schedule 4B (as varied by s38A & 38C of the Town and Country Planning Act) Neighbourhood Planning (Referendums) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

A referendum relating to the Wickhambrook Neighbourhood Plan will be held on **Thursday 13 November 2025.**

The question to be asked at the referendum is: **Do you want West Suffolk Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Wickhambrook to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?**

The **referendum area** is identical to the area which has been designated as the Wickhambrook Neighbourhood Plan Area. See below.

The **persons entitled to vote in the referendum** are those who:

- Are entitled to vote in an election of a councillor to West Suffolk Council.
- Have a qualifying address for the election in the referendum area.

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2424.13 and has been calculated on the basis of 1053 electors.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures similar to those used at local government elections.

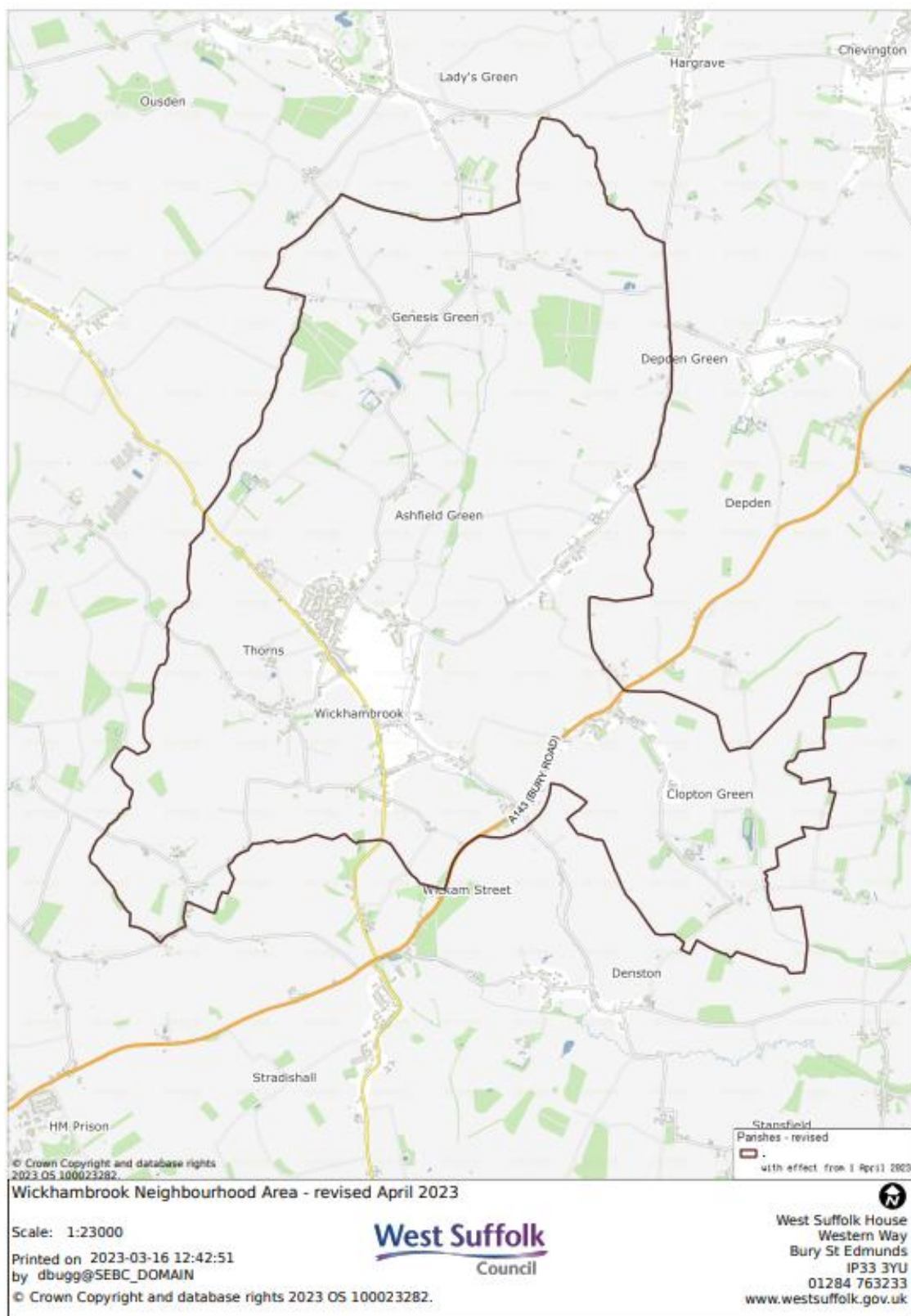
