What is a Hate Crime?

A Hate Crime is any crime committed against a victim or a group because of who they are or what they believe in.

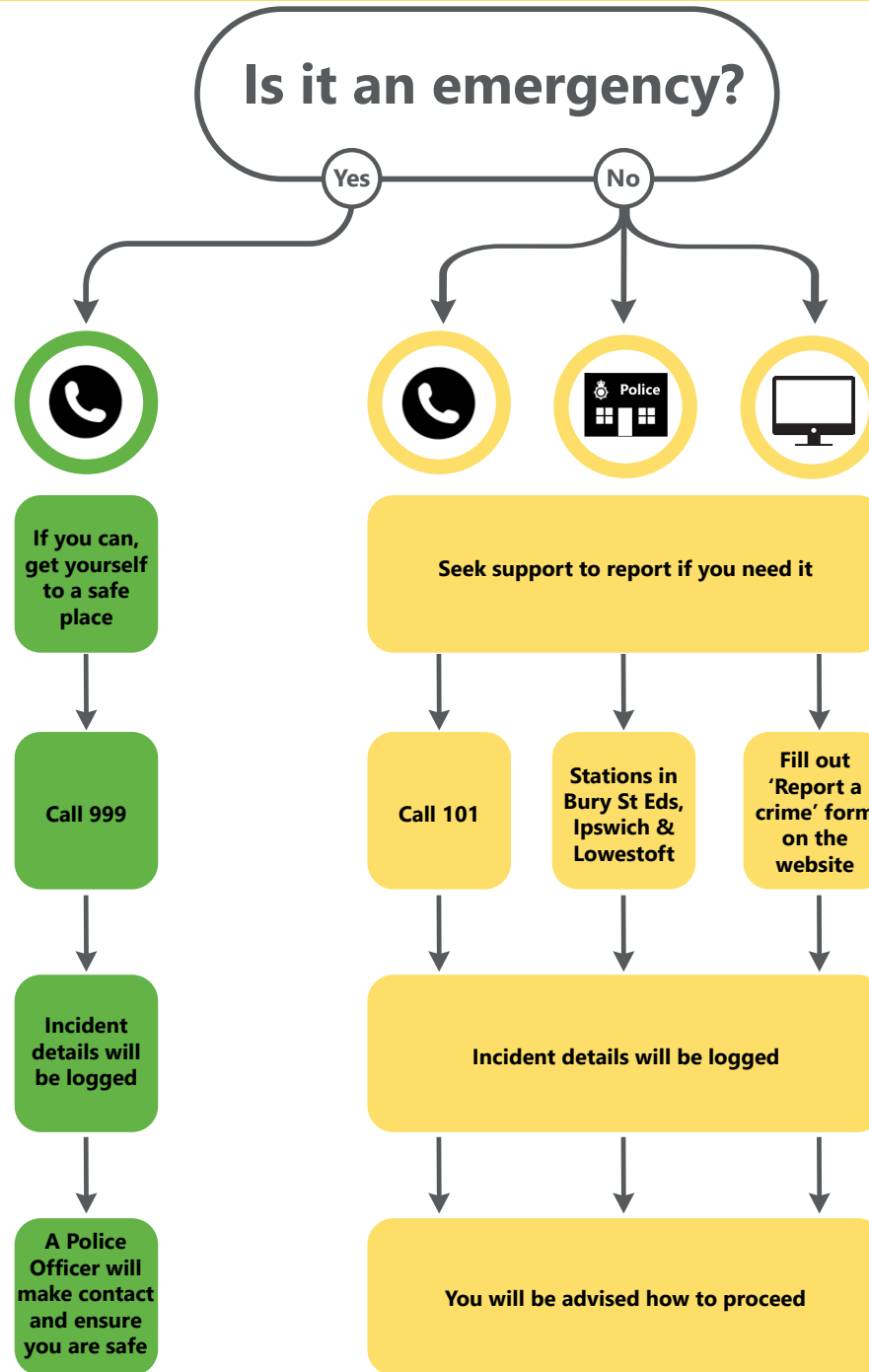
